



INSPECTOR'SBOOTCAMP



The skilled trades industry is one that has been struggling for years with new generations of high school graduates. In recent years there has been more of a call to action to bring attention to the many benefits of working in the skilled trades.

Fire protection is a specialty skilled trade – an even more difficult place to find technicians that the more commonly known trades such as electrical and plumbing/HVAC. People in our industry are always complaining that we cannot find enough good labor. Hiring is our top business challenge and it has been for years.

The only way to combat this trend is to INVEST. It is our responsibility as a business in this trade to put in the time and money to help bring in the tradespeople of the future.

With this in mind, Fireline has begun our "Inspector's Bootcamp" program. One to two times per year we are hiring a class of students and putting them through a 10 week program to teach basic test and inspection of fire alarm and sprinkler systems.

The class is lead by our Training Manager Matt Meyers and supported by various field "mentors". The 10-week course includes classroom training, field ride alongs, shadowing, safety training, technology training and customer service training.

Our first class graduated this past January – congratulations to Calvin York, Alex Dibbern and Jack Sigmon! These three are well on their way to starting a great career as inspectors.

Our spring 2024 class is currently underway with 5 students. We look forward to seeing them complete this course and becoming graduates themselves.




